Inquests

If a public authority was involved in a death, or the events leading up to a death, an inquest may be held. The inquest will investigate the nature of the death and factually record what happened.

Inquests can be held in order to investigate the following:

- Death in a care home

- Death in hospital
- Death in the community
- Death by suicide
- Death from a road traffic accident
- Other deaths

Fees and Funding

Public Funding (Legal Aid)

Legal aid is given to eligible individuals who cannot afford to pay for legal advice and representation. We will advise as to whether legal aid funding may apply in your case. When it does, we can assist you in making the necessary applications for funding and advise you of your financial obligations.

Conditional Fee Agreements ('No Win No Fee')

In some cases, we offer a conditional fee agreement, commonly known as 'no win no fee' funding. To determine if your claim is eligible, we will assess the prospects of success in your case.

If you win your claim your opponent should be responsible for paying some of your legal costs and disbursements. Any legal costs payable by you will not be payable until the conclusion of your case. Generally no legal costs are payable if a 'no win no fee' claim is unsuccessful.
